# How to Recognize an Inspiring Child





## They tend to communicate by:

- Telling stories
- Sharing personal feelings
- Expressing opinions readily
- Speaking quickly
- Using an abundance of inflection



## Their body language might consist of:

- Animated facial expressions
- Spontaneous actions
- Continued contact
- Energetic movement

# Here are some conversation or speech pattern identifiers:

- They may talk and listen in “feeling” terms
- They may be talkative
- They may use varied tones when speaking
- They may move from serious to light-hearted topics quickly
- They tend to tell everything they know

# They are people-oriented

- They genuinely love people and are highly social
- Their prime directive is to win friends and influence people
- Their energy and enthusiasm inspire others to join in

# They are talkative

- They are persuasive communicators and LOVE to talk
- They often tell colorful and entertaining stories and jokes





# They are emotional

- They tend to display their emotions freely and openly
- They are animated, dramatic and they react emotionally to people and events
- On the flip side, they may have a difficult time with criticism

# They are spontaneous

- They enjoy a variety of activities and need the freedom to follow their feelings and go with the flow
- Being free spirited, they tend to be impulsive and disorganized
- They dislike structured environments or anything that would limit their personal freedom
